INTERNET PRIVACY POLICY

BullAnt Security Pty Ltd (the Company)

By using this site, you agree to the Internet Privacy Policy of this web site (“www.bullantsecurity.com.au”), which is set out on this web site page. The Internet Privacy Policy relates to the collection and use of personal information you may supply to the Company through your conduct on the web site.

The Company reserve the right, at the Company’s discretion, to modify or remove portions of this Internet Privacy Policy at any time. This Internet Privacy Policy is in addition to any other Terms and Conditions applicable to the web site. The Company do not make any representations about third party web sites that may be linked to the web site. The Company recognize the importance of protecting the privacy of information collected about visitors to the Company web site, in particular information that is capable of identifying an individual (“personal information”). This Internet Privacy Policy governs the manner in which your personal information, obtained through the web site, will be dealt with. This Internet Privacy Policy should be reviewed periodically so that you are updated on any changes. The Company welcome your comments and feedback.

1. Personal Information

Personal information about visitors to the Company site is collected only when knowingly and voluntarily submitted. For example, the Company may need to collect such information to provide you with further services or to answer or forward any requests or enquiries. It is the Company intention that this policy will protect your personal information from being dealt with in any way that is inconsistent with applicable privacy laws in Australia.

2. Use of Information

Personal information that visitors submit to the Company site is used only for the purpose for which it is submitted or for such other secondary purposes that are related to the primary purpose, unless the Company disclose other uses in this Internet Privacy Policy or at the time of collection. Copies of correspondence sent from the web site, that may contain personal information, are stored as archives for record-keeping and back-up purposes only.

3. Disclosure

Apart from where you have consented or disclosure is necessary to achieve the purpose for which it was submitted, personal information may be disclosed in special situations where the Company have reason to believe that doing so is necessary to identify, contact or bring legal action against anyone damaging, injuring, or interfering (intentionally or unintentionally) with the Company rights or property, users, or anyone else who could be harmed by such activities. Also, the Company may disclose personal information when the Company believe in good faith that the law requires disclosure. The Company may engage third parties to provide you with goods or services on the Company behalf. In that circumstance, the Company may disclose your personal information to those third parties in order to meet your request for goods or services.

4. Security

The Company strives to ensure the security, integrity and privacy of personal information submitted to the Company sites, and the Company may review and update from time to time the Company security measures in light of current technologies. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet can be

guaranteed to be totally secure. However, the Company will endeavour to take all reasonable steps to protect the personal information you may transmit to the Company or from the Company online products and services. Once the Company receives your transmission, the Company will also make the Company best efforts to ensure its security on the Company systems. In addition, the Company employees and the contractors who provide services related to the Company information systems are obliged to respect the confidentiality of any personal information held by the Company. However, the Company will not be held responsible for events arising from unauthorized access to your personal information.

5. Cookies

Cookies are data that a Web site transfers to an individual's hard drive for record-keeping purposes. Cookies, which are industry standard and are used by most Web sites, including those operated by the Company, can facilitate a user's ongoing access to and use of a site. They allow the Company to customize the web site to your needs. If you do not want information collected through the use of Cookies, there is a simple procedure in most browsers that allows you to deny or accept the Cookie feature.
